Please submit the full-text paper before **August 1, 2013** after you receive the confirmation for your abstract to ICWMT 8. For one delegate, no more than two papers can be allowed to be submitted at the ICWMT 8.

All the accepted papers will be formally **published by Trans Tech Publications** and submitted for **EI (Engineering Index) and CPCI (ISTP) index**. The excellent papers will be published in a special issue of **SCI** journal after peer review.
